Game Changers is an exciting 20-session programme designed for **students in years 7-9**. The programme uses relatable texts, highly-scaffolded resources and (optional) football activities to motivate and equip young people to read.



Represent is a 10-week programme designed for girls aged 11-14. With a focus on oracy, the programme uses appealing and relevant texts to engage students in discussions and activities that develop their reading comprehension skills, resilience, wellbeing, relationships and communication.

Whilst the content was designed with girls in mind, we support delivery with mixed gender groups as well.
